

QUEEN ELIZABETH PARK – stage 3

KEY

1. Park Avenue Entrance

- 1a. Rationalise vehicle entry to the Park – retain existing vehicle access as main entrance from Park Avenue.
- 1b. Reduce asphalt around the entrance and create a footpath along the southern boundary of the park within the road reserve area of Park Avenue.
- 1c. Cemetery entrance to become pedestrian entrance to cemetery and park.
- 1d. Retain large trees – crown lift specimen trees along the boundary between the park and cemetery to open up visual lines. Under plant with bulbs etc for colour.
- 1e. Install new permeable fence between the park and cemetery. Alignment and placement of fence to consider the location of existing structures, trees, graves etc.
- 1f. Create new carpark within existing concrete area (approx. 14 carparks)
- 1g. Retain and upgrade the existing Peacock aviary, introduce bird feeders + opportunity for public purchase food and feed the birds not in captivity (Doves etc).
- 1h. Remove the old concrete block aviaries.



- 2. Pioneer Cemetery
- 2a. Create new car park on the old aviary site, (approx 16 carparks).
- 2b. Enhance the existing Grave Diggers Cottage and provides opportunity for interpretation.
- 2c. Redefine the edges of the Pioneer Cemetery with permeable fence around the perimeter – alignment and placement of fence to consider the location of existing structures, trees, graves etc.
- 2d. Re configure existing entrance to Pioneer Cemetery incorporating Founders Structure.
- 2e. Review existing vegetation and develop a vegetation management strategy within the pioneer cemetery.
- 2f. Relocate newer portion of implement shed (to implement yard on Park Ave) and create car parking area (approx.8 cars). Accessible car parks to be those closest to Cafe and painted with wheelchair symbol.
- 2g. Establish new gardens under Redwoods and along southern edge of Cafe.
- 2h. Service access to Cafe and Bowling Club, (approx. 3 Carparks).
- 2i. Create outer green edge to oval, opportunity to set existing significant trees into lawn.
- 2j. Reuse of existing Heritage building into public toilet and Bowling Club facility.
- 2k. Reuse existing tennis court area for Bowls parking, review access and reduce netting.
- 3. Botanical Area – Herbaceous Border
- 3a. New vehicle access for all Parks and Grounds staff from workshop and yard.
- 3b. Review existing vegetation and develop strategy to enhance botanical / woodland area – new plantings, bulbs etc.
- 4. Interpretation Strategy + Conservation Plan.
